**A.**

**For Lowell CHC patients** - If you have symptoms or who have been exposed to someone with COVID-19, please call **978.937.9700** to arrange for a test, either at the health center or at Lowell General Hospital.

## When can I get a COVID-19 vaccine in MA?



### PHASE ONE

In order of priority

- Clinical and non-clinical healthcare workers doing direct and COVID-facing care
- Long term care facilities, rest homes and assisted living facilities
- Police, Fire and Emergency Medical Services
- Congregate care settings (including corrections and shelters)
- Home-based healthcare workers
- Healthcare workers doing non-COVID-facing care

**December - February**

Estimated timeframes



### PHASE TWO

In order of priority

- Individuals with 2+ comorbidities (high risk for COVID-19 complications)
- Early education, K-12, transit, grocery, utility, food and agriculture, sanitation, public works and public health workers
- Adults 65+
- Individuals with one comorbidity

**February - April**



### PHASE THREE

Vaccine available to general public

**April - June**
